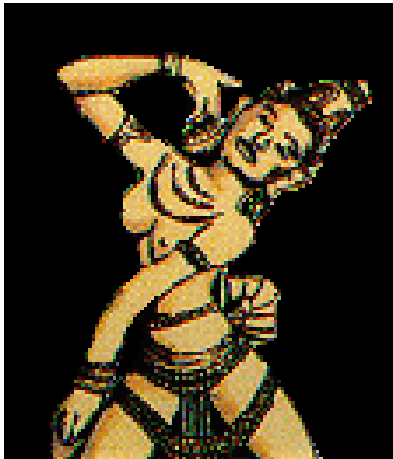

Covering approx 600 sq km, it contains more than 100 fabulous ancient monuments and over dozen major compound Temples, which were built during the most splendid Era of the <b>Khmer Dynasty</b> between the 9<sup>th</sup> – 13<sup>th</sup> century and were the ancient capital of the <b>Khmer Empire</b>. The constant building program undertaken by successive Khmer kings can be compared favourably with the pyramid construction projects of the Pharaohs in Egypt. Similar to the Pharaohs, the Khmer kings made use of a vast force of slave labour. Each new "project" was made possible by the 750,000 people estimated to have lived at Angkor during the 12th and 13th centuries. Here, travellers will have experiences about Cambodian's Spirit value worth through Ancient Temples (worshipping Shiva-Hindu, or Buddha, Khmer Kings), the stately vestiges of Old Palaces, Royal Courts, ancient Terraces, Public Building, collapsed citadels and antique Towers.</p> <p>Our experienced tour guides will transmit you the most lovely aspects of <b>Angkor Temples - during 25' by coach</b> from the Airport to your luxury Hotel in the centre of town. Day 2	<b>SIEM RIEP</b> full day tour		<p>After breakfast, let's experience a full day tour to discover Siem Riep.</p> <p>Firstly, visit <a href="#">Angkor Wat</a> – one of the seven greatest architectural wonders of the world, as a temple and mausoleum for <a href="#">King Suryavarman II</a> at the peak of the Khmer empire in <a href="#">the first half of 12<sup>th</sup></a>, Angkor Wat is probably the best-preserved of the Angkorean temples, with a central tower surrounded by four smaller towers. The central monument represents the <a href="#">mythical Mount Meru</a>, the holy mountain at the centre of the universe, which was home to <a href="#">the Hindu God Vishnu</a>. The whole complex covers 81 hectares, a rectangular wall measuring 1025 metres by 800 metres borders the inner edge of the moat, and temple's greatest sculptural treasure is its 2 km-long bas-reliefs around the walls... Continuing to the most rememberable Temples that built from 9<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> century such as: the <a href="#">Southern Entrance Gate of Angkor Thom</a>, <a href="#">Bayon Temple</a> – built by <a href="#">Jayavarman VII</a> at the end of the 12<sup>th</sup>, in the exact center of <a href="#">the city of Angkor Thom</a>, proceeding to <a href="#">Baphuon</a>, <a href="#">Terrace of the Elephants &amp; Terrace of the Leper King</a>.</p> <p>Finally, in the late afternoon, coming to the <a href="#">Phnom Bakheng temple</a>, is <a href="#">the first temple in Angkor region build by the YacovarmanI King</a> in the first of 9<sup>th</sup> century, located on a slope gently hill where thousands tourist are grouping on the hilltop to catch a memorable time of life when viewing the marvellous sunset.</p> <p><b>Lunch</b> : will be hosted in the <a href="#">riverside restaurant</a>, there is a <a href="#">local restaurant</a> located in a green area, decorated and deeply impressed as colonial style. Day 3	SIEM RIEP full day tour	PHNOM PENH	<p>A half day tour for Angkor complex on morning, visit <a href="#">Kravan, Srasb Srong, Ta Keo temples</a>, is a pyramid on 5 levels whose total height is 22 metres and dedicated to Shiva, continuing to visit most rememberable Temples that build from 9<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> century such as: <a href="#">Preah Rup, Preah Neak Pean , Preah Khan &amp; Ta Phrom Temple</a>, was a monastery built by Jayavarman VII as a residence for his mother. Ta Prohm has been controversially left to the destructive power of the jungle by French archeologists to show how nature can destroy man's work. It has been largely overgrown by the jungle and as you climb through the dilapidated stone structures you see many giant trees growing out of the top of the temple itself. <a href="#">Ta Prohm</a> looks as many of the monuments did when European explorers first laid eyes on them.</p> <p>Back to hotel for a late lunch, free at leisure until check-out then transfer to the airport for a flight to <a href="#">Phnom Penh</a> by <b>FT 703 at 16.25-17.10</b></p> <p>Arrive <a href="#">Phnom Penh</a> - the city retains <a href="#">its traditional Khmer</a> and colonial charm. Inside its floor is constructed of 5000 silver tiles. In the center of the pagoda there is a magnificent 17th-century emerald Buddha statue made of baccarat crystal and its walls enclosing are covered with frescoes depicting episodes from the Khmer version of the Ramayana.</p> <p>A nice photo-group picture should be catch in the <a href="#">Mekong River Bank</a>, where is ideal place with great back-view of <a href="#">Royal Palace compound</a> , or <a href="#">Independence Monument</a>, inaugurated in 1958 to celebrate Cambodia's independence. Proceeding to <a href="#">Cambodia's National Museum</a> offers a charming setting for a stunning collection of ancient Khmer art.</p> <p>Finally, visit <a href="#">Toul Sleng Genocide Museum (S-21)</a> a memorial and a testament to the madness of the Khmer Rouge regime, <a href="#">Toul Sleng</a> kept extensive records, leaving thousands of photos of their victims. Day 9	VIEN TIANE full day tour - LUANG PRABANG		<p>Laos, '<a href="#">land of a million elephants</a>' and one of the last places to see old Indochina. Laos' isolation from foreign influence offers travellers an unparalleled glimpse of traditional southeast Asian life. From the fertile lowlands of the Mekong River valley to the rugged Annamite highlands, Laos is <i>the</i> highlight of southeast Asia.</p> <p>Sits on a bend in the Mekong River amid fertile alluvial plains. Despite its chequered past, <a href="#">Vientiane is a laid-back city</a> with a number of interesting wats and lively markets.</p> <p>Full day tour to visit <a href="#">Wat Sisaket</a>, built in 1818 by Chao Anou - the very king responsible for incurring the wrath of the Siamese and causing his capital's obliteration. The interior of the main hall, and the walls of the surrounding courtyard, are inset with thousands of tiny niches and shelves containing <a href="#">6840 Buddha images</a> and <a href="#">Buddhist inscriptions</a> from the 18th century. Then <a href="#">Patouxai war memorial</a>. Inspired by <a href="#">the Arc de Triomphe in Paris</a>, the Patouxai (<a href="#">Lao for Gateway of Victory</a>) is adorned with an array of rough hero Lao historical imagery and offers a splendid, panoramic view of the city from its top. Proceeding to <a href="#">Wat Ho Phakeo</a> - a former royal temple, built in 1565 by <a href="#">King Setthathirat</a>, the temple was originally designed to house the famous <a href="#">Emerald Buddha</a>, which he had brought with him from the Kingdom of Lanna, <a href="#">That Luang</a> - The most important national monument in Vientiane, is a symbol of both Buddhism and Lao sovereignty, was constructed in 1566 by <a href="#">King Setthathirat</a></p> <p><a href="#">Lao Revolutionary Museum</a>, a monument to Laos' long struggle to free itself from colonization.</p> <p>Check-out, transfer to the airport for a flight to <a href="#">Luang Prabang</a> by <b>QV 103 at 16.30-17.10</b>. Day 10	<b>LUANG PRABANG</b> inside fullday tour		<p><a href="#">Luang Prabang</a> today is a small, peaceful town with a remarkably well-preserved combination of Lao and colonial French architecture, which led to <a href="#">UNESCO World Heritage in 1995</a>. Though virtually nothing of the magnificent 14th century capital of <a href="#">Fa Ngoum</a> has survived the ravages of time and numerous invasions, the city is still a veritable treasure trove of beautiful temples, and historical monuments of the kingdoms that rose and fell in the centuries that followed.</p> <p>Visit <a href="#">Wat Xieng Thong</a>, with its golden facades and mural paintings, is a masterpiece of 16th century Buddhist architecture. The temple was used for the highest royal ceremonies and to temporarily house the bodies of the deceased kings, proceeding to <a href="#">Wat Mai</a> temple from in 1821 , and <a href="#">Wat Visounarath</a>, inside you will see the stupa which is know as that Makmo because the form is like the half of Watermelon. <a href="#">The National Museum</a>, formerly the Royal Palace, situated on the banks of the Mekong River, was constructed to French designs for King Sisavangvong between 1904 and 1909, also a vast assortment of gifts and other paraphernalia collected by the former kings and queens of Laos, and a replica of the country's palladium, the <a href="#">golden PraBang</a>. Finally, visit <a href="#">Phousi temple</a> with 382 steps up to take a good view of the beautiful sunset, of greater Luang Prabang and Mekong rivers on surrounding.</p> <p><b>Lunch</b> : Set-menu lunch of 5 courses in a local restaurant which located <a href="#">Nam Ou Riverside</a>, with a-la-cart drink ( maximum of 1/2 bottle of wine or 2 cans of beer or soft-drink per pax, free-flow of mineral water, tea and coffee )</p> <p><b>Dinner</b> : Pick-up by the <a href="#">colourful rikshaws</a>, they will carry you strolling around <a href="#">Old Quarter and shopping old streets</a> to a very traditional restaurant.
